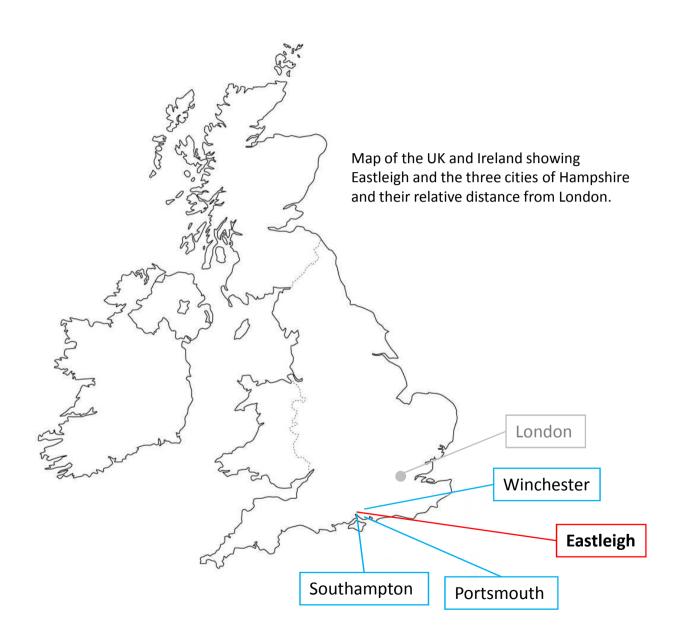

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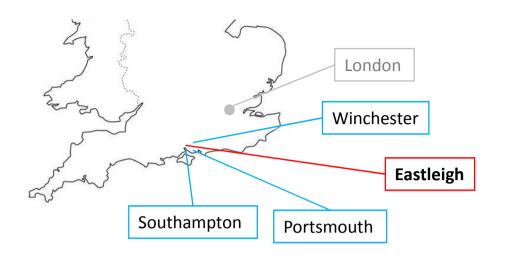
Eastleigh in Hampshire, UK













- Eastleigh is at the centre of a creative hub fed by four universities producing over 7,000 graduates in cultural and creative disciplines every year (Smith, 2009).
- The number of creative firms and creative jobs in Eastleigh are both above the national average (Chapain, 2010).
- Arts participation in Eastleigh is 50.6% which is above the 45.2% national average (Audiences South et al, 2010).
- The performing arts, music and visual arts are the largest employers in the UK's creative industries sector (DCMS, 2011).
- In 2010 the creative industries accounted for 5.1% of employment in the UK (1.5 million people) and this figure continues to rise (DCMS, 2011).
